

## THE MISGUIDED BUSWAY

### The "Green Belt" Countryside Surrounding our Villages Remains under Threat!

The Greater Cambridge Partnership (GCP) intends to carve a tarmac busway 14 metres wide around Shelford and Stapleford cutting across the fields adjacent to Magog Down - one of the most beautiful landscapes in Cambridgeshire.

Land alongside the route will be open to speculative housing development.


There is a better and less damaging alternative and we need **YOUR** help to make it happen.
