PROGRESS SUMMARY

- Site Strip 100% complete
- Site welfare and storage setup 85% complete
- S278 for temporary access 95% complete
- Hoardings to Chalk Hill and temp access (started timber posts 30% complete)
- Haul roads in place and 80% tarmac complete

1. Construction Working Hours

- a. Our construction partner Bennett Construction (BCL) start work at 08:00 and finish work at 17:00. Currently the site operatives finish work at 16:30 due to the lack of natural daylight.
- b. There are no current plans for any weekend working.
- c. Working hours one incident of significant late working. This was due to a delayed concrete delivery arriving late and halfway through a concrete foundation pour and therefore had to be completed. BCL have spoken with the concrete plant supplier and advised them about working hours. BCL have issued a 'tool box talk' to explain to their supply chain about working hours and that if deliveries are late to the site again, they will be turned away.

2. Street Cleaning Plan & Regime

a. BCL have a full-time road sweeper in operation throughout the dig, we will also be setting up a wheel wash at the front gate.

3. Road Works & Utilities

4. Construction Traffic

a. Construction lorries to our site are directed to approach the site from the A1307 and where possible to avoid going through the village.

5. CCTV

a. The construction site will install CCTV week commencing 5th February.

6. Road Safety

- a. Damage inflicted on Haverhill Road grass verges we have spoken with highways, and they have suggested installing cones on the grass verges to help protect them from vehicles.
- b. We shall be installing road speed restriction signage to the site hoarding.
