Ash - Tidy previously shattered limb. Shorten damaged limb by 5-6m. Reduce height and spread on all sides by 3-3.5m and shape round. Remove deadwood. Major over-extended primary limb on north side has evident splitting at union with the main stem, compromising the limb and main stem itself. Significant risk of further structural failures above owners and neighbours gardens.
